


### Preamble

Giani Zail Singh-Punjab Technical University Campus, Bathinda is the first technical institute in the state of Punjab which was established as Govt. Engineering College Bathinda in the year 1989. The Late Hon'ble Governor of Punjab Sh. S.S. Ray laid the foundation stone on 23<sup>rd</sup> October, 1989 with a view to impart enriched quality of technical education in this backward Region of State to update technical knowledge to compete with rapidly changing modern technology in the world and to interact effectively with the industry of the region. The Campus is spread over an area of 156.6 acres situated at Dabwali, Road, Bathinda with lush green land offering most charming view with peaceful effect. Moreover, its distance from hustle and bustle of city also creates perfect ambience for smooth growth of professional education.

Later on in the year 1992 the name of the college was changed by the Punjab Government as College of Engineering & Technology, Bathinda and registered as society under the Society Act 200 of 1960 for the registration of literary, and charitable trust society under the control of Government of Punjab and a "Board of Governors" (BOG) was constituted to manage the affairs of the college. In the year 1996, in honour of late President of India Giani Zail Singh, who also hailed from this region, college was renamed as "Giani Zail Singh College of Engineering and Technology, Bathinda" by the Punjab Government.

### Introduction of GZS PTU Campus Bathinda

Giani Zail Singh College of Engineering and Technology, Bathinda is the first Graduate level technical institution in the state of Punjab which was established as "Government Engineering college, Bathinda" in the year 1989 with the full financial support of Punjab State Government with a view to impart quality technical education in this backward region of the state. In Dec 2011 with the aim to put emphasis on Post Graduate studies and Doctoral Research, the college has been made as constituent college of Punjab Technical University, by Punjab State Government for promotion Postgraduate courses and research activities and renamed "Giani Zail Singh-PTU Campus, Bathinda". It is now with the objective to play pivotal role in producing quality technical manpower being the **second campus of Punjab Technical University**. The campus will strengthen its learning culture, research, and institutional structures, academic and co-curricular programs necessary to embody these three commitments and to uphold the standards of excellence, **shared governance and academic freedom**. It aspires to be a university that is open to the world and distinguished by its search for excellence in research, its high-quality learning environment, its passion for knowledge and innovation, its leadership on technical issues and its openness to diversity.




#### Need of the Development Assistance

The institution has grown and expanded steadily. Over the years, the annual intake of seats in various B.Tech, M-Tech, MBA, MCA and M.Sc courses has increased from 210 in 1989 to 964 in 2013. The campus has 06 full-fledged Engg. Departments and One School of Architecture and independent Depts. of Applied Physics, Applied Chemistry, Applied Mathematics, Computer Applications and Deptt. of Humanities & Management Studies. In addition to this college is running a Regional Centre of Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar for Post graduate (present intake 125) and Ph.D. courses. Diploma courses in five trades with intake of 300 students were also started in the year 2009. The aim of Institutional Development Assistance under TEQIP-II is to strengthen the institution to produce high quality engineers and ultimately to meet the real issue of quality of teaching-learning in engineering education. The G.Z.S Campus Bathinda has a mission and vision to produce engineers and technologists with a strong scientific base and awareness of social needs. Technology changes very rapidly and therefore, the facilities in every technical institute become obsolete very fast. Due to incorporation of latest technology in curricula modernization of lab laboratories in every discipline is utmost necessary as the present equipment in various labs are quite old. Therefore, it is always necessary to support technical institutes regularly by providing financial assistance to develop infrastructure, physical facilities, library and faculty training. Having analyzed its current status, its internal strengths and weaknesses, and the threats and opportunities presented to it by its environment, GZS PTU Campus has to maintain its excellence and expand it in new directions, and confidently take hold of the opportunities it perceives in its background.

#### Academic Governance.

- PTU Jalandhar Granted full academic autonomy to campus and also applied to UGC for 12B registration including GZS-PTU Campus, Bathinda.
- Academic Council of campus is approved by BOG in July 2013.


GZS-PTU Campus set up its own Examination Branch for conduct of examinations after being granted Academic autonomy. End semester examinations are conducted locally including preparation of Date sheet, Setting of Question papers, conduct of Examinations and subsequently evaluation and compilation of results of all students. The result is declared after showing the Answer sheets to students within a week of end of Examinations. With student centric academic & operational philosophy, we ensure that our students grow academically, professionally, socially as well as spiritually in a stimulating campus environment. In addition GZS - PTU campus is striving hard to achieve excellence in technical education through continuous pursuit. Since 2011 there has been a substantial increase in number of seats for UG as well as PG courses.






21.07 Academic autonomy for FTU G2S, Bahinda

It was informed that Government has transferred G2S/CET Bahinda to FTU as its Campus.

It was informed that Gen Zakir Singh College of Engineering & Technology, Bahinda (now FTU G2S Campus Bahinda) has been selected for Sub Component 1.1. Strengthening Institutions to improve Learning Outcomes and employability of Graduates (Modernization and Strengthening of Laboratories for existing UG) under the Technical Education Quality Improvement Program (TEQIP-II) of the Government of Andhra Pradesh. For the above purpose, autonomous institution status is required for the Campus.
